that pile up on the road to their discovery and to examine the ways of putting them out of action or rendering them harmless through his brilliant account of the fears and anxieties that weigh on us today bauman alerts us to the scale of the task which we shall have to confront through most of the current century if we wish our fellow humans to emerge at its end feeling more secure and self confident than we feel at its beginning
